Correspondence:

- PC Ian Kennedy sent a report of one recorded crime in Beighton in September but no recorded crimes in October. It was noted that there have been four burglaries in Acle recently.
- The Annual Return has been completed and returned by Mazars.
- NCC is consulting on the need to find reductions of £189m. The councillors felt unable to choose any area for reductions as all services were felt to be necessary.
- Broadland District Council is hosting an event to promote Community Resilience Plans. The clerk will attend.
- The Broads Authority has arranged an event to examine the impact of climate changes on the community.
- BDC sent details of the Draft Supplementary Planning Document for the Food and Agriculture Hub.
- There was a query about the ownership of some land in Acle Road, Moulton. The councillors did not know who the owner is.
- The clerk has booked to attend the Practitioners' Conference in February and has applied for a grant towards the cost.
- The subscription is due for the oil syndicate via Norfolk Rural Community Council. It was agreed to pay the £20 fee for another year.

The Parish Council will then need to purchase grit for the bin as Norfolk County Council have stated that, as there is already a grit bin further along Chapel Road, they will not fund another one. Ivan Cator offered to keep the bin filled with grit if residents let him know when it is getting low.
3. The clerk was asked to contact Highways to get the drains cleared out in Acle Road, Moulton, opposite the garden centre and at Apple Tree Corner.
