


**NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL  
(BEIGHTON)  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ORDER 2020  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)**

ORDER prohibiting the use by vehicles of the C875 Reedham Road from a point 130 metres south east of the 59300 Ash Tree Road for a distance of 100 metres south eastwards in the PARISH OF BEIGHTON

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that:-
  - (i) Openreach maintenance works are required at the C875 Reedham Road from a point 130 metres south east of the 59300 Ash Tree Road for a distance of 100 metres south eastwards in the PARISH OF BEIGHTON (hereinafter referred to as the said road) and:
  - (ii) that in consequence traffic over the said road should be prohibited with effect on 5<sup>th</sup> April 2020 for the duration of the works expected to be about 1 day within the period.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a vehicle which requires access, to proceed to a final destination situated within the length of road specified in Article 1 of this Order.
3. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works after obtaining consent of the Secretary of State.

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect on 5<sup>th</sup> April 2020 for the duration of the works the said road SHALL NOT BE USED by any class of vehicle.
