

DID YOU KNOW?

Beighton Parish Council are the trustees for the **Beighton and Moulton Poor's Allotments** charity (*charity number 211411*). It owns land in both Beighton & Moulton which is rented to local farmers. Historically, a proportion of the income received from the rent was distributed to the 'poor' in both villages.

The trustees distribute money to approximately 20 parishioners each year, usually between November and February, which is reviewed each year at the charity's annual meeting. The charity's name is a little misleading in a modern world and the trustees would like to make it known that the money can be distributed, at their discretion, to anyone who might be considered worthy recipients of a little extra cash. This might be because that person has fallen on hard times, whether through losing their job, dealing with an illness, or just finding life hard for whatever reason or, may be, because they have given up their time to do something in the Parish that benefits us all.
