

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO6860) affecting the High Road from 50m south of its junction with Old Cantley Road for 50m southwards in the PARISH OF CANTLEY, LIMPENHOE AND SOUTHWOOD to facilitate new water connection works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 11th to 13th July 2023 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: High Road, Coxhill Road, Sandy Lane, Acle Road, Lodge Road, School Road, Station Road, Norwich Road, Long Lane, Stone Road, Wood Lane (Beighton, Lingwood and Burlingham, Strumpshaw, Cantley, Limpenhoe and Southwood).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

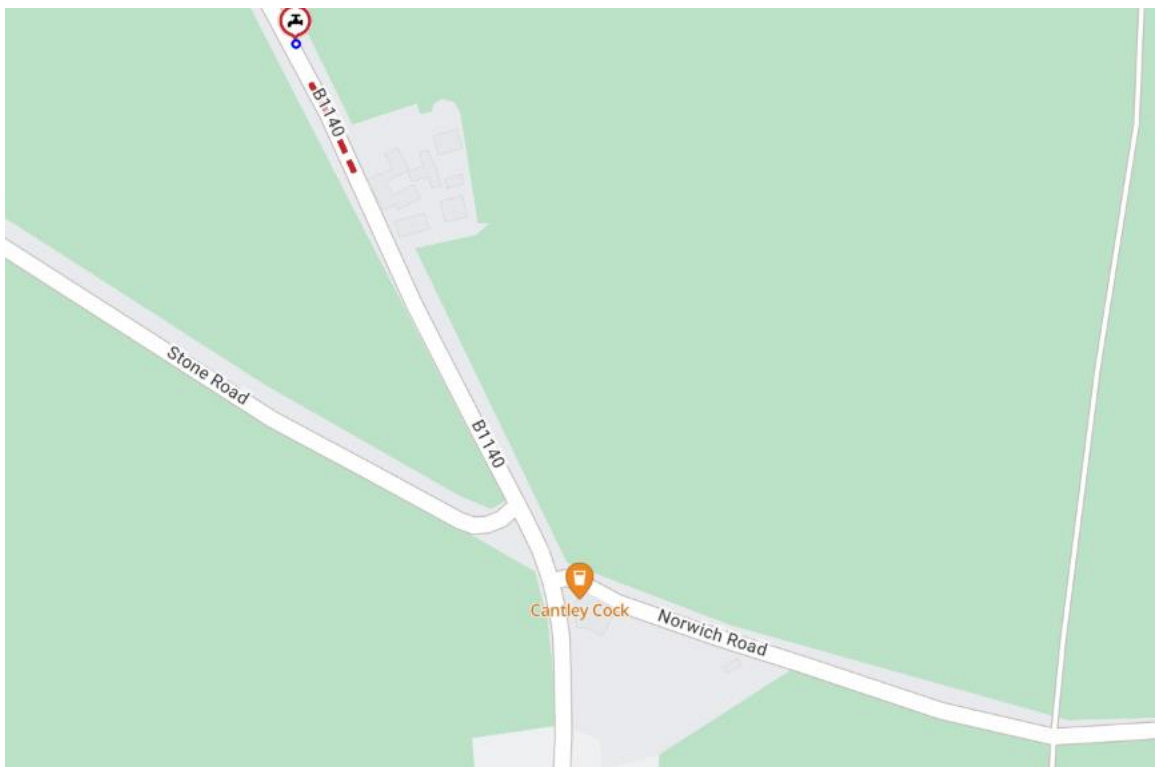
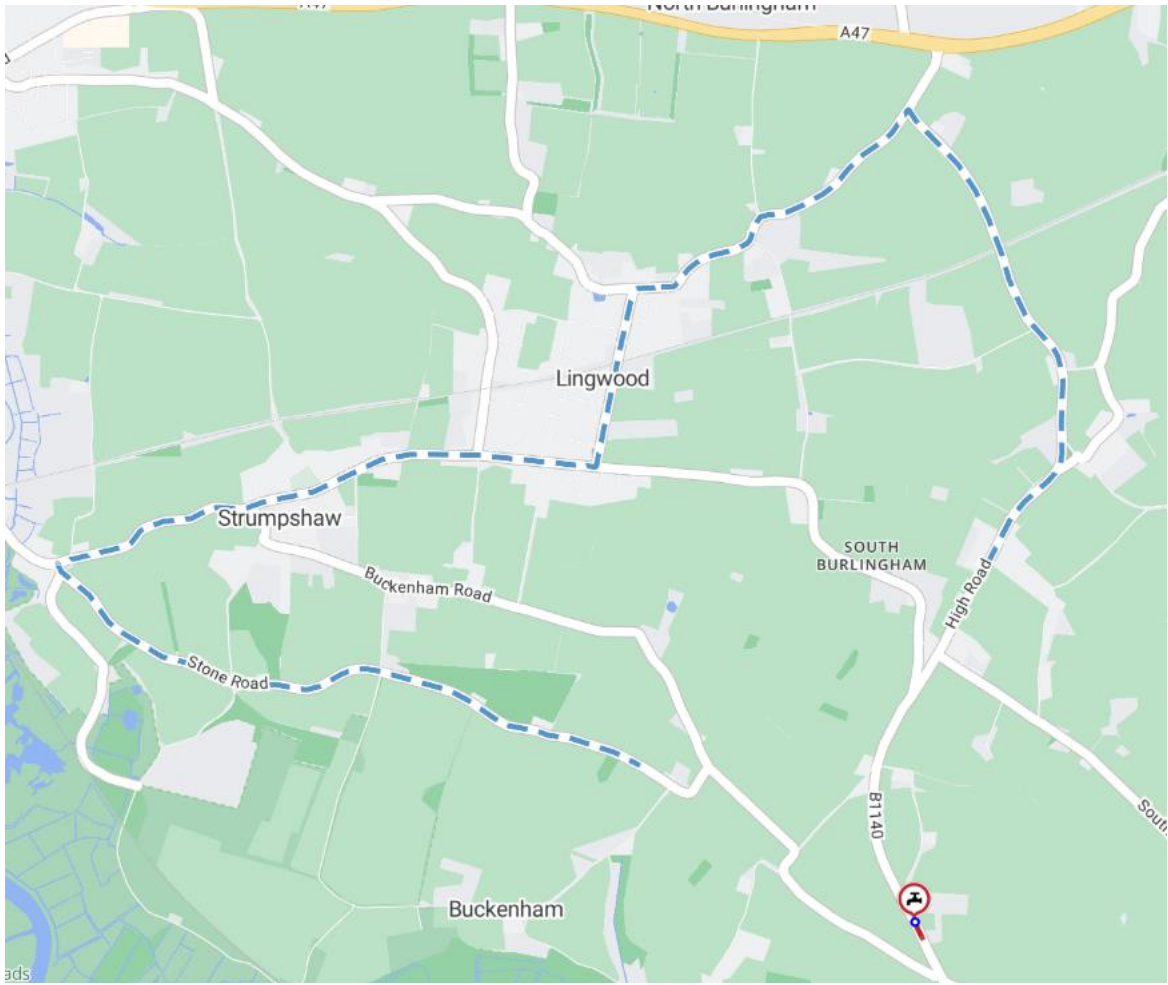
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
