NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7592) affecting The Green from 10m south of its junction with Palmers Lane for 40m southwards in the PARISH OF FREETHORPE to facilitate Anglian Water sewage works.

This Order continues the provisions of the Order dated 9th February 2024 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect from 24th to 28th February 2024 (previously 12th to 23rd February 2024) for the duration of the works expected to be about 5 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: The Green, Lower Green, Reedham Road, Porters Road, Grove Road, The Common, Chapelfield (Beighton, Freethorpe, Cantley, Limpenhoe and Southwood).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
