

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7824) affecting the Beighton Road from its junction with A47 West Bound Slip Road for 342m south westwards in the PARISH OF ACLE to facilitate highway drainage works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> April 2024 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Beighton Road, Church Hill, Stone Corner, Coxhill Road, Acle Road, A47 from Acle Parish Boundary to Halvergate Parish Boundary, A47 from the start of the dualling West of J B1140 to J A1064 W, Norwich Road, Leffins Lane (Beighton, Lingwood and Burlingham, Acle).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

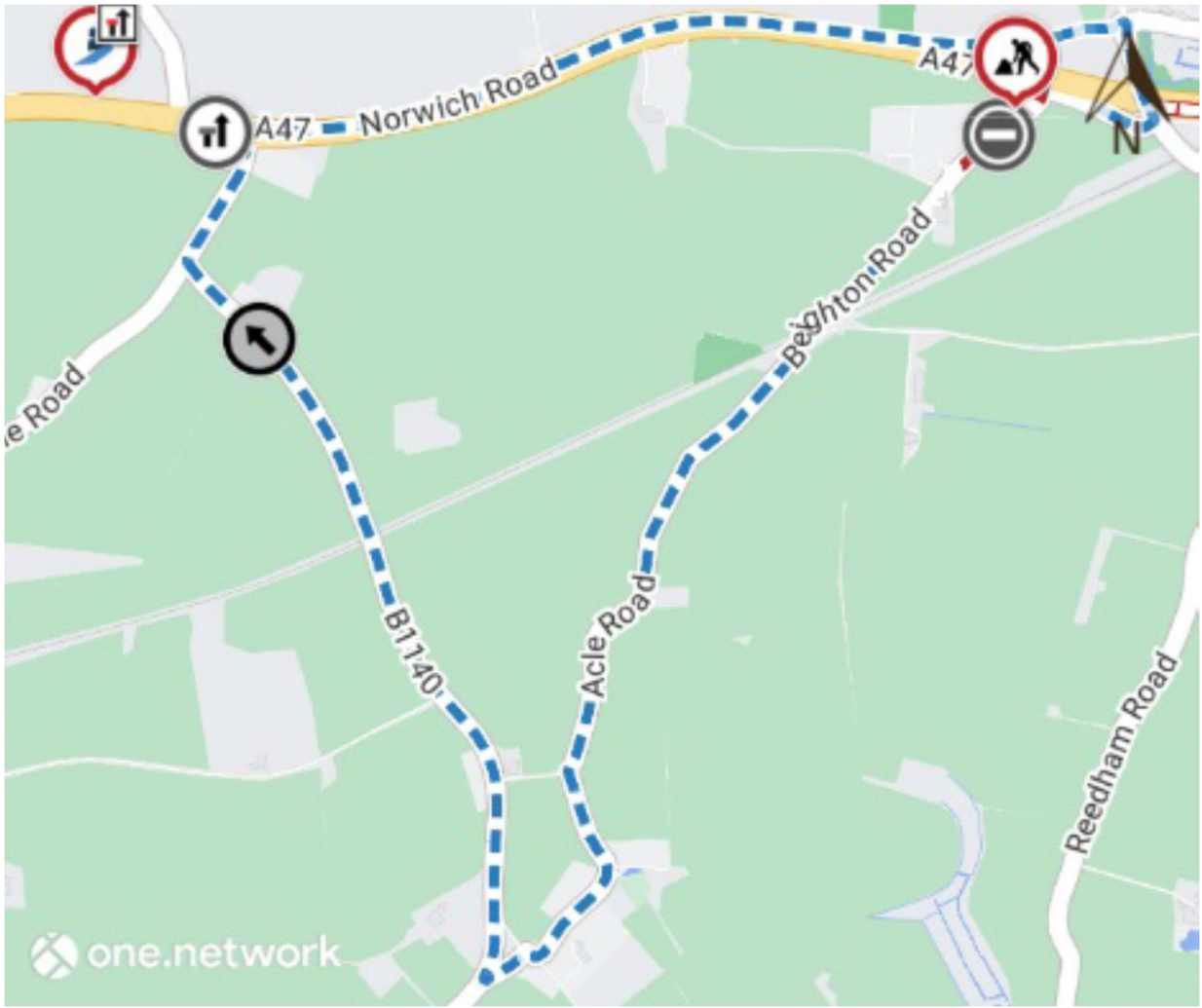
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
